2017 ROBIN HÄGG GRANT

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The *Robin Hägg Memorial Fund* is pleased to offer a grant of 1,500 € to a post-doctoral scholar working in the field of Aegean prehistory who wishes to conduct research in Greece. Candidates from all countries who have completed their doctorate within the past eight years and are under forty years of age are eligible to apply. Applications must be received by e-mail no later than **31 January 2017**.

In addition to the completed application form, proposals should include a *curriculum vitae* of the applicant, a 2-page description of the project that emphasizes the importance of working in Greece, relevant bibliography, copies of appropriate permits, and one letter of support from a colleague. The grant will be administered by the INSTAP Study Center for East Crete and is intended to provide supplementary income for researchers who are either exploring new fields of study or finishing research. The amount of the award is 1,500 € which can be applied to travel or living expenses, but should not be used as salary or for the purchase of equipment (e.g., cameras or computers).

Consideration for the fellowships is open to all candidates meeting the stated requirements. Awards are made irrespective of race, gender, religion, national origin, age, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, and actual or perceived medical conditions. It is possible that in the absence of qualified candidates with appropriate projects, a fellowship will not be awarded.
